First Steps at The Chestnuts Riding School...

Total Beginner: Your first step would be an Introductory Lesson, followed by a series of Private Lessons. Once you can safely Walk, Trot and Canter independently, you would typically join Group Lessons and go Hacking to further your riding experiences.

Novice and Above: You would have to take a Private Assessment or a Group Assessment. If we feel you're safe, you will be allowed go Hacking and join a suitable Group Lesson for your ability.

Alternatively: If you don't want to learn how to ride, you can go on a handler led Horse/Pony ride.

What Equipment do I need?

Riding Hats: We have all sizes and provide them FREE of charge.

Footwear: We have most sizes, but it's worth checking we have your size. If you bring your own footwear, make sure they have a Heel, and are not too wide. (Trainers, Flip-Flops, Hiking Boots are not allowed).

Body Protector: We don't provide these because each must be a perfect fit. We highly recommend all clients wear a body protector.

Apparel: Jodhpurs and a Riding Jacket are recommended, alternatively, sports type clothing is suggested (long sleeve for added protection).

Layers are important during the winter months!

HOW DO I BOOK?

What is an Rider Registration Form?

A mandatory document and disclaimer you must complete before participating in any activities on site. It asks for Personal Details, Emergency Contacts, Medical Conditions, Previous Riding History, and for completion of a Disclaimer, riding is a risk sport, you participate at your own risk.

What is an Assessment / Introduction Lesson?

It's a Private Lesson 1-to-1 with an instructor, a mandatory first step if you wish to learn to ride properly. If you're a total beginner, it will be an introduction to the basics, on the lunge (the horse is tethered to the instructor via a lunge line) at first, then working towards independent Walk, Trot and Canter during further Private Lessons.

If you can already ride, the instructor will silently assess you, and counter sign your stated ability on the Rider Registration form by going through exercises to determine your level and ability.

What is a Private Lesson?

1-to-1 tuition with an Instructor. On average it takes a beginner 10 lessons to reach a **proficient** Walk and Trot standard and to be learning canter. For a competent rider, more advanced subjects can be taught, with the emphasis on correcting faults and becoming a better rider.

What is a Group Lesson?

A class of 3 to 7 other Riders being taught by a single instructor, you'll participate in group exercises to reinforce your riding skills, as well as correcting faults and occasionally practicing jumps.

We run both child and adult only group lessons regularly, admission is subject to availability and riding experience. At a minimum, every rider must be able to Walk and Trot proficiently.

What is a Hack/Trekking?

Riding out on the South Downs with an Experienced Escort. We have the best and most accessible (8 minutes to reach a Bridle path) Hacking in the area, absolutely no Road Riding.

Trekking is a **Walk Only** Hack, it's aimed at Beginners with little experience, the Horses will be geared up with Western Saddles for added safety (they have a Pommel which you can hold on to).

What is a Jumping?

Learning to take a horse over various obstacles, from trotting polls, to Show Jumps up to 3ft depending on rider ability and previous experience. There is much greater risk to the Rider while jumping, but most find it exciting. A Body Protector is highly recommended!

What is a Horse/Pony Ride?

If you're looking for a taster, we offer a handler led Ride on the South Downs. It's a great way to experience riding out on the downs, without the worry of control.

Pony for the Day

A Horse/Pony for a day! (Aimed at Children during Holidays only). Starts at 10:00, finishes at 16:00, a participant will Groom, Tack and Un-Tack and other stable management. They get 2 hours of Riding minimum. This is only suitable for riders who can Walk, Trot and Canter (novices).
